UPDATE ON THE FLOOD RELIEF PROJECT

The Founder-President of MIMC Ven. Sanghasena Mahathera along with some members of the Mahabodhi Flood Relief Committee visited the villages of Saboo, Taru and Phyang to make an assessment of the damage caused to these villages by the recent flash floods. He met with the affected villagers and the village heads and assured of all possible help to them from Mahabodhi and expressed his heartfelt consolation to those who had lost their near and dear ones.

The team also visited the GREF Camp, SNM Hospital and Army Hospital and met with the 14 students studying at Mahabodhi School and their parents who had lost their homes and badly affected by the floods. Ven. Sanghasena expressed his condolences to those who lost their relatives and assured to extend all possible help to the affected students who have lost their parents in the Mahabodhi Hostel and look after their educational expenses.

All the staff working at the various wings of Mahabodhi voluntarily came forward and offered to contribute 50% of their salary to the flood relief efforts being undertaken by Mahabodhi. The students studying in 5th standard and above also will skip their dinner for two days in a week for one month and the money thus saved will be donated to the flood relief project.
